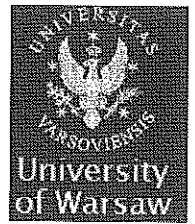

MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING (MoU)
concluded by and between
UNIVERSITÀ DEGLI STUDI SUOR ORSOLA BENINCASA (ITALY)
and
UNIwersytet Warszawski
(the UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW, POLAND)

UNIVERSITÀ DEGLI STUDI SUOR ORSOLA BENINCASA, with its seat in via Suor Orsola 10, 80135 Naples, C.F., 80040520639, represented in this act by the Rector, prof. Lucio d'Alessandro, and the UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW, with its seat in ul. Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warszawa, represented in this act by the Rector, prof. Marcin Pałys,

both institutions hereinafter referred to as "the Parties",

agree to establish academic, scientific and cultural cooperation in the area of education and research. In particular, cooperation between the Universities could take into consideration one or more of the following activities:

- Exchange of students, including PhD students;
- Exchange of academic and other staff members;
- Joint research projects;
- Exchange of information and scholarly publications;
- Organization of seminars, workshops, scientific meetings and lectures;
- Other activities being subject of mutual interest.

The present MoU does not entail any economic and financial effort and/or transfer of resources for one or both Parties.

Details of each activity to be undertaken under the present MoU will be previously agreed upon in writing by both Parties and will be subject of availability of funds.

In case of visits of professors and/or PhD students the home institution covers travel expenses, while the host institution covers accommodation expenses for stays of a maximum length of 2 weeks per year.

Any and all further costs will be agreed by and between the Parties, if needed.

The contact persons in charge of the present MoU will be:

- For the Università degli Studi Suor Orsola Benincasa – Prof. Lucio D'Alessandro;
- For the Uniwersytet Warszawski – Prof. Hanna Serkowska, Department of Italian Studies.

During implementation of the present MoU the Parties will comply with legal regulations being in force in their respective countries.

The intellectual property rights of the publications being a result of joint research will be safeguarded in accordance with legal regulations of both countries.

Any disputes that may arise during implementation of the present MoU will be settled amicably.

The present MoU will become effective on the day it is signed by legal representatives of both Parties and will remain binding for 5 (five) years. Each Party may terminate the MoU upon a written notice to the other Party. In case of termination of the MoU any related activities in progress shall continue until completed.

The MoU was made in two equivalent copies in English, with one copy for each Party.
