The objective of this proposal is the creation of a Chair in “European Protection Law of Individuals in relation to New Technologies” (PROTECH) at the Università degli Studi Suor Orsola Benincasa (Faculty of Law) with special reference to: (a.) Data subjects in digital habitats, with particular regard to Minors and Elderly Persons; (b.) Consumers in digital habitats, with particular regard to Minors and Elderly Persons; (c.) Embryos, unborn children, new forms of life created in laboratory.

The name proposed for the Chair intends to create a new label to highlight the protective approach in European Law, regulating the relation between individuals and technologies, since the relationship with technologies could place them in a position of vulnerability even if they do not have disabilities. By “vulnerable individuals” we intend all persons who act in a technological environment, where they are more exposed to the risk of damages as they are in a “vulnerable” position for different reasons (minor/old age, asymmetry of contractual power or information, see points a. and b.). We include in this large category human embryos as well: they are a crucial example of exposure to risk of damages because they do not act but they are ab origine created in a technological environment (see point c.).

The teaching course proposed is a complete novelty for the Law Students at UNISOB, because European Protection Law encompasses a variety of topics linked to specific EU policies, but with the uniform aim of protecting individuals in their contact/interaction with technologies, including human embryos.
The proposed course will be a compulsory course for Law and Economics students and an optional course for other students (Psychology, Science of Primary Education, Business Administration and Green Economy, and Foreign Languages and Literatures, LL.M. and Ph.D. candidates), but also Professionals and policy-makers.
