Objective

The European Commission's proposal for a Regulation on a Common European Sales Law (CESL) is a ground-breaking initiative for consumers and businesses in the internal market. The proposal is highly controversial and has come up against resistance from some Member States and numerous other institutions.

This conference, scheduled before the trilogue between Council, Commission and Parliament in October 2013, offers a platform to debate the main issues at this crucial stage. The Lithuanian EU Presidency, the European Commission and the European Parliament will be represented at this conference in Trier.
